SUMMER FUN CAMP

Summer Fun Camp is a 2-week summer camp program ETC designed to meet the developmental, social and behavioral needs of children with Asperger's Syndrome, high-functioning autism, attention and anxiety disorders and other challenges. Summer Fun Camp this year includes Games for Interaction and we are introducing a program that allows parents the opportunity to suggest a group activity for us to design. All activities at Summer Fun Camp are for team-building and social groups targeting communication and group skills. Children will be placed in small groups to enhance their experience.

Group B: Ages 11-16

MONEY MATH: LESSONS FOR LIFE: Grades 6-8 \$250.00 (min 4 students) July 19-23 or August 9-13 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. *Course shows students how to apply math skills to some of life's costly challenges, learning important personal finance concepts and consumer awareness along the way.

PRACTICAL MONEY SKILLS: Grades 9-12 **High School .5 credit either math elective or Occ Ed credit (45 hours, \$50/hour).** *Course teaches students how to set long and short-term personal and financial goals, create and work with a personal budget, identify how and when to use credit, save and invest, and understand the basics of banking services. Plus students will be tracking the stock market, keeping an expenditure diary, and making decisions!

American Sign Language (ASL) for Parents

\$450 (min 2)

For those seeking to increase their ASL skills. All levels welcome.
Class is 8 weeks, twice a week, for 1.5 hours each session.

Conversational Signing

\$200 (min 2)

For hearing adults who know a deaf or hearing-impaired signer
and seek some basic signs and vocabulary.
Class is 4 weeks, meeting twice a week, for one hour each session.

Signing with Baby

\$120 (min 2 families)

For mom, dad and baby/child who is pre-verbal.
Class is 4 weeks, meeting once a week, for one hour.

Bring a blanket or mat.

Signing with the Non-verbal Child

\$120 (min 2 families)

For mom, dad and child who is non-verbal.
Class is 4 weeks, meeting once a week, for one hour.

CLASSES FOR HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT (1:1 or small group)

2010 SUMMER PROGRAMS

Core & Elective Classes For Credit, Academic Tutoring, Individual Test Preparation

Welcome to summer 2010 at ETC. ETC Summer Program extends from Monday, June 14th, through Tuesday, August 31st. Individual programs may begin and end on any date within the above timeframe; arrangements can be made to go outside of these dates. **Course times can be designed around your summer vacation plans.** A single session is 55 minutes in length. Students may elect to have a 1-1/2 hour session (85 minutes with breaks) or double sessions (110 minutes with breaks). Your learning plan with ETC will be an important and rewarding part of your summer!

CREDIT COURSES

Earn credit in a core subject or elective area in order to get ahead for next year, repeat a class, or study a subject not offered at your school. We offer 1:1 and small-group learning opportunities in most subject areas. Our experienced instructors will individually design a curriculum for you, from traditional and honors classes to instruction for students with learning disabilities.

TUTORING

Learn new skills, improve existing skills, or prepare for upcoming subjects at school. Our instructors tutor in all subject areas including executive functions. Students are matched to teachers based on subject-area expertise and personality fit. Our students exit our programs prepared for the challenges of the school year!

TEST PREPARATION: SAT, ACT, ISS, HSPE, BYU AND MORE!

We offer a full range of options to prepare you for upcoming standardized tests. Increase your confidence and improve your scores!

SPEECH & LANGUAGE THERAPY

Boost articulation, comprehension, expressive language, and literacy skills over the summer. Space is available for students aged preschool – adult. Our certified speech-language pathologists can provide you with an evaluation, or we can follow your school's treatment plan. Use summer as a fun, easy opportunity to maintain and improve upon important communication skills.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Current/returning students: Mail, fax or bring your summer registration form to ETC. Our registration fee is \$60.

New students: Please call our office for information on how to register as a first-time student.

Our scheduling process begins May 25th. Every effort is made to give students their requested days and times. If this is not possible we will call to discuss other options before final schedules are completed. Students attending schools that require pre-approval for outside credit must get approval for the class before registering.

Completed schedules: Parents are called when schedules are complete, which typically occurs during the week of June 7th. Schedules must be picked up and paid for within five days of start date in order to maintain reserved spots. If not picked up and paid for in that time, the scheduled times will be released for other waiting students.

SAT/ACT PREPARATION - (class size 2 minimum; 8 maximum)

SAT or ACT Semi-Private Class

\$450/student

Create a class for you and friend (min 2)

SAT Math Prep

\$450/student

Participate in an intensive study of the math content and strategies needed to succeed on the SAT. Classes are 2 hours per session, twice a week. The cost includes a mock SAT exam that will be scored and then returned and reviewed the last night of class.

SAT/ACT Essay Writing Prep

\$300/student

ETC will schedule a 2-hour class meeting, twice a week, for 2 weeks. The price includes a mock SAT or ACT exam (min 4)

SAT Critical Reading & Writing Prep

\$450/student

The course offers an intensive study in the Critical Reading and multiple-choice sections of the Writing portion of the SAT. Content will include vocabulary, grammar & strategies. Classes are 2 hours per session, twice a week. The cost includes a mock SAT exam that will be scored and then returned and reviewed the last night of class.

SAT/ACT 1:1 Exam Prep

\$48/hour

Study only those subject areas where you need help! Learn at your own pace!

Mock SAT & ACT Administration

\$60/hour

The Mock is free with SAT Prep Class registration. Students who take only a mock SAT or ACT exam pay \$60. Most **non-standard accommodations** are available upon request. Test results are mailed within 2 business days. Juice and snack are provided.

ACT Math/Science Prep

\$450/student

Math and Science content and strategies are practiced for the student seeking success on the ACT exam. Classes are 2 hours per session, twice a week. The cost includes a mock ACT exam that will be scored and then returned and reviewed the last night of class.

ACT English/Reading Prep

\$450/student

Find success on the ACT verbal sections by focusing on grammar, reading efficiency and strategies unique to the ACT. Classes are 2 hours per session, twice a week. The cost includes a mock ACT exam that will be scored and then returned and reviewed the last night of class.

College Counseling Camp

\$500/student

Juniors and seniors, College Counseling Camp is for you. This 3-day (12-hour) camp will help you build a superb college admissions portfolio. We'll focus on making appropriate academic choices, creating the college resume, the college search, the application and other pertinent things to consider as you begin to think about your college choices. Juniors will organize their investigation of post-secondary academic options and take the stress away from the college search experience in grade 12. A senior taking this course will leave with a completed application, a final college essay, a complete college resume and a finalized list of college choices. In addition, seniors will practice for their final SATs. All of the above guarantees that seniors will have a less stressful first semester of their senior year. **This class is only offered June 28, 29, and 30th from 9:00 a.m.- 1:00 p.m.**

SUMMER TUITION COSTS

Tutoring 1:1: \$48/session scheduled

Credit classes 1:1: \$50/session scheduled (45 sessions are required by most schools for one semester credit)

Academic group classes for credit: Class tuition is determined by the number of students participating in the group; group tuition is lower than 1:1 tuition. Please contact our main office for further details.

Speech-language therapy: \$100/session

Pre-approved payment plans available if full tuition is a hardship

CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations of entire programs after confirmation of schedule, but before the 1st scheduled day, will be assessed a fee equal to 10% of the instructional charge for the student's program.

Cancellations of entire programs after the 1st session, but prior to the 6th session, will be assessed a 20% fee.

Cancellations of entire programs after 5 sessions will not receive a refund.

Students must attend all scheduled classes. The 7 a.m. cancellation policy does not apply during the summer session.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

Additional charges may appear on your monthly statement for the following (if applicable):

- Curriculum materials
- Mileage charges (\$.50/mile) for locations other than the ETC Main Office or Lutheran Church campus
- Prep records fee of \$60 per class for credit through ETC Preparatory Academy
- Consulting fees of \$100/hour, prorated
- Rescheduling fee of \$60 for significant changes made after a student has been scheduled and confirmed
